Our Values are based on Values of both RESULTS International Partnership and the ACTION Coalition and tailored for the Australian context by RESULTS Board and staff. We are:

**1 Equity Focused:** Our work is guided by the belief that every person has a right to fair and equitable access to health, education, economic opportunity and voice regardless of race, religion, age, gender, sexual orientation, education, or wealth.

**2 Evidence Based:** Our advocacy is evidence based and grounded in the global health and development evidence base of credible, impartial and reliable sources of research and best practice information

**3 Collaborative:** We believe cooperation, partnership, trust and collaboration with elected representatives, other decision-makers, researchers, champions, international partners, allies, engaged citizens and communities are critical in shaping political priorities, achieving our goals and sustaining measurable impact on diseases of poverty and equitable access to health, education, economic opportunity.

**4 Accountable and transparent:** We seek to be open, accountable and transparent partners with each other, our supporters, funders and allies; a responsive and credible resource for those to whom we advocate; and responsible and effective champions on behalf of those for whom we advocate.

**5 Bold and effective Advocates:** Based on the clear and ambitious vision of our mission, our advocacy is passionate, inventive, persistent, powerful, accountable & transparent, strategic and creates measurable outcomes and impact.

**6. Builders of Knowledge, Capacity & Empowerment:** With education, training and support each of us has the potential to use our voice and become a powerful advocate whose actions to educate parliamentarians, the media and the Australian community contributes to a world without poverty
